The great exaltation (?) of our nation from the prime to the farmer is every pleasing. We have reason to feel happy about the victories and pray to God for future victories, which will be needed to reach our aim. But the great losses throw a dark shadow over our happines. One has to focus on the general situation (the cause of which was not created by our leaders) in order to overcome personal suffering and pain.

In Sobernheim two hospitals have been put up. Theodor writes that young doctors are needed - should you know of any, please let him know.
