Dear Mrs. Bleek,

In reply to your letter of the 27th ult., as far as I know, apart from my checking each example, Vedder's 111 (peculiar lateral) corresponds to my retroflex click — definitely retroflex and a peculiarity of !kū. If Mrs. Lloyd intended !! for a click between ! and 11, it would seem to me to be a corroboration of my analysis of the retroflex position. The retroflex click of !kū savours of ! but has a "scrape" which is somewhat reminiscent of 11, as you will see from the description I give of it. I think you would be safe to interpret Vedder's 111 and Mrs. Lloyd's !! as the retroflex, and in the orthography you use, I should say the latter (!! the more acceptable symbol. I am glad to know that you are nearing the completion of your dictionary work.

Did you see my reference to your Father's work in "African Studies",
